Desperate Tories axe the planks

As the Tories prepared to abandon their sinking ship they hacked at the thin planks that help to keep disabled people afloat, in a desperate attempt to generate division and dodge blame. They have already ensured that disabled people and their families account for one third of people living in poverty. In the latest slash and burn action, the Government initiated plans to cut disability benefits to force sick and disabled people into work with rhetoric reminiscent of Oliver Twist and pushing children up chimneys. Does the election offer hope?

The bottom line is an alternative Government can't be worse so yes our hearts should lift up. Sadly however Labour, who are most likely to get a majority are not committing to stop the war on disabled people or take radical steps to implement a National Care, Support and Independent Living Service other than improving the pay and conditions of care workers They are utterly hamstrung by being wedded to the status quo with - fiscal prudence, "growth" and a narrow notion of work as making profit for someone else,

which excludes the crucial work of caring and mutual support on which we all rely from cradle to grave. However we do have some allies in the Labour Party and will be turning the heat up not down after the election.

The Green Party's policy is close to ours as both grew out of ESCaD's precursor, 'Reclaim Social Care' but so far they have only one MP.

The Lib Dems are something of a dark horse as they have been much less cagey about speaking up about Social Care than Labour and have expressed a commitment to pursuing free personal care along the limited Scottish model as well as providing more support to carers. It probably helps that Ed Davey, their leader, has relevant personal experience
